CASA JUNIOR SWIMMING RULES

1. Judges

All Judges' decisions will be final.

2. Entries

- (a) Child's age is that which they attain by or on 31st December in the calendar year of the competition.
- (b) Where more than 1 competitor may enter an event, the strongest swimmer must compete as the A swimmer

C – 3rd place from school carnival

B - 2nd place from school carnival

- A 1st place from school carnival
- (c) Open Events Any age may compete in Open events.
- (d) Junior 10 years and under Senior - 11 years and over

Students must compete in the one category only.

(e) Competitors must be currently enrolled and attending a CASA school in Year 2-6

3. Restrictions on Entrants

There are no restrictions on the number of events a competitor may enter.

4. Marshalling

- (a) All swimmers in an event **MUST** be in the marshalling area prior to the first heat being conducted.
- (b) Competitors must wear their school swimming cap.
- (c) Parents, coaches and unauthorised persons are not allowed in the Marshalling area or on pool deck. Once competitors are in the hands of the marshalling, they shall receive no coaching.

5. Starting

- (a) Whistle to stand on back of block.
- (b) Take your mark.
- (c) Electronic beep.

6. Place Getters

- (a) Place-getters will be determined by the Electronic Scoreboard. Judges will need to let Scoreboard operators know of any disqualification.
- (b) All competitors must remain in the pool until told to leave by the Chief Judge.
- (c) First three place-getters of each event will receive a place ribbon.

10. Lane Draw

Where possible schools are rotated annually with lanes to be allocated when coordinator is preparing the program.

11. Relays

- (a) Will all be conducted over 50 metres per individual.
- (b) Age relays 4 x 50m
- (c) Best of the Best best 8/9, best 10, best 11, best 12/13

12. Referee

Rules to be observed shall be in accordance with the International Body except where stated otherwise. The referee shall be the sole arbiter in points under dispute. The referee shall be the CASA Swimming Convenor or his/her nominee.

13. Protests

Protests shall be dealt with by the Disputes Committee consisting of CASA Swimming Convenor, Referee (if a delegate is appointed by the CASA Swimming Convenor), a NSW Swimming Official and one other Sport Coordinator or his/her nominee. No protest shall be considered unless lodged in writing by the Team Manager (who must be a teacher) with the committee within 15 minutes of the conclusion of the event.

14. Timing

Electronic timing and touch pads will be used. Each lane will be timed, times can be checked on the electronic scoreboard.

15. Winner

The winner of any event is the person whom the judge agrees touched the wall first without being disqualified.

16. CIS Qualifications

The top three fastest qualifiers for each event will qualify for CASA representation at the CIS Carnival on Wednesday 27 March. The next two fastest are reserve for each event and will be notified if they qualify. If an athlete does qualify for more than one event and pulls out of an event on the day CIS will fine the athlete \$20 (CASA will not cover this fee).

If an athlete pulls out of an event – notification must be given to the team manager at least 24 hours before the CIS Carnival.
