CASA NETBALL RULES

- All Australian Netball Association Rules will apply. Official score sheets will be supplied for all games.
- All games will occur on the indoor courts, inside the Netball complex.
- Each team is expected to provide a match ball and one umpire (qualified at District Badge level) for their own game that they play. The umpire's whistle shall start and finish games on the indication from the central timing device.
- ALL TEAMS MUST SUPPLY AN UMPIRE, capable of controlling the game District Badged or National C Badged.
- CIS Netball are looking at selecting <u>Secondary student umpires</u> to represent CIS at the PSSA Championships. I will be looking at taking 1 or 2 Secondary students to umpire for CASA at the CIS trials. All umpires representing CIS need to be in YEAR 9 or above (14 years or older).
- All teams to be correctly attired in their school playing uniforms,
- Players shall be numbered 1 10 on their arm and on the outer side of each calf muscle.
 MAXIMUM of 10 players per team.
- Each team is to have available two (2) sets of position patches, of different colours (in case of blood policy).
- Score sheets will be filled out with player's numbers in positions (instead of names) and these should be recorded on the score sheet prior to the scheduled start of each game.
- Each team shall provide an official scorer who shall sit with the scorer from the opposing team.
- One (1) official from each team is to sign the score sheet. Score sheets are to be returned by the winning team immediately after each match.

- Playing time
- Each game will consist of two x 9-minute halves
- The half time break shall be two (2) minutes.
- Substitution of players is permitted in accordance with official rules.
- Up to two (2) minutes injury time may be taken according to official rules, but no additional time shall be added to the match.

Scoring

- The classification of teams in any group or pool situation shall be made on points according to their win/loss record, namely:
 - o 3 points for a win
 - o 1 point for a loss
 - o O points for a forfeit
 - o 2 points for a draw.
- If at the end of the carnival there are teams on equal points then <u>joint premiers</u> will be awarded no goal count-back shall be used.

First Aid

• First aid will be in attendance on the day

Canteen

• Canteen facilities are available at the venue. As the day comprises many short games, students should pack small, nutritional snacks as well as water for the day.

Parking

• There is a three (3) hour free parking validation in P3 & P4 car parks as shown on the attached map. Parents/officials attending can validate their parking ticket at Netball Central reception desk for the first 3 hours. An approx.. hourly rate of \$5.00 applies after 3 hours.

Selections

- Players and umpires selected to represent CASA will need to be available to attend the NSW CIS Netball Gala Day on Friday 17th May 2024 (Term 2).
 - Players and umpires will need to arrange their own transport for this day.
