CASA NETBALL RULES

- The Co-Educational Schools Association Netball Day will be governed by the rules according to the All-Australian Netball Association. The following rules will also
- The umpires will be checking nails and jewellery. Players will not be able to take the court with fake or long nails or jewellery. (This includes taped earrings and nails)
- There is no injury time or time stopped for any reason except blood where there is a period of 30 seconds allowed. If there is an emergency, the game will be moved over to the nearest court. (This may be outside)
- Each division will be allocated courts where the round robin games will be played. (See Draw) If there are any disputes, a teacher from the school ONLY should contact the umpire's convenor and the dispute will be dealt with.
- 7. U/15's and opens will play in a pool competition with a final series

Playing time

- Playing time will be 12 minutes per half with 2 minutes for half time and 4 minutes change between games for U/15's and Open Teams
- Playing time will commence at the start of the hooter and stop with the hooter.

Scoring

• A representative from the two (2) schools playing will score together. Immediately after the match a representative from the winning team should bring the score sheet to the recording desk.
