CASA SENIOR CRICKET GALA DAY RULES & INFORMATION YEARS 7-8 & YEARS 9-11

DATE: Monday 25th November, 2024

TIME: 8.00am – 3.00pm

VENUES: Jackson Park, Woodbine (Years 9-11)

Jamison Park, South Penrith (Years 7-8)

RULES

All normal cricket rules apply, with the following exceptions:

- o If both teams are ready and the assigned pitch is not being used, then you are encouraged to start games earlier then the scheduled time.
- o Eight (8) overs per inning
- o All eleven (11) players on the field
- o No bowler can bowl more than two (2) overs.
- o Overs cannot be consecutive.
- o Batter to retire at 50
- o 5 minutes' changeover
- o Next batsman needs to be padded and ready to bat (as per Big Bash cricket)

EQUIPMENT

Each school needs to provide:

- o One match ball
- o Own Cricket Score Book
- o One spare set of stumps/bails
- o First Aid Kit
- o Shade shelter/Marquee (the shade shelter can stay on the same field for the day and be collected at the end)

POINT SCORE

o Two (2) points will be awarded for a win and Zero (0) for a loss.

- o In the event of a draw at the conclusion of the pool stages, the winner of the match between the two (2) teams will be awarded the higher position. If this match was a draw, then the team scoring the most runs throughout the day will be awarded the higher position
- o In the event of scores being tied, a 6-ball super over will take place. If a winner is still not found then the team losing the least wickets over the course of the match (including the super over) will be the winner. If teams are still even, then the match will be a draw

CANTEEN

- o There will be no canteen available on the day.
- o All players to bring food and drink for the day
