CASA VOLLEYBALL RULES

- Normal FIVB Rules apply eg: setting off a serve is allowed, serve may hit the net off a serve.
- One 30 sec time-out permitted per set (sets 1-2). No time outs in 3rd set.
- Substitutions are permitted between two players.
- If playing a libero, they must be clearly marked and follow libero rules (back court only, only serve for the replaced plater, no attacking shots – over height of net)
- Students cannot deliberately hit the ball with feet/head.

Playing time

- 30min game max. Best of 3 sets (all 3 sets to be completed). First to 15 points with a two-point advantage required to complete a set.
- In the event 3 sets have not been completed in the time frame then a set is considered complete if a minimum of 10 points have been scored by one team and there is at least a 2 point lead.

- 5 min break between games.
- Coaches are to umpire each game. (Alternate coaches/umpires each set)

Scoring

- Each team is required to have a scorer sitting together. One will use the score sheet, the other using the electronic scoreboard
- Score sheets must be completed by both teams and signed by coaches. It is the coaches responsibility to send these score sheets to the recording areas immediately following each game.
- 3 points will be allocated for a win. 2 points for a draw. 1 point for a Loss.
- Should there be a tie on points at the end of day, then for and against will be used to determine final places sets first then game points if required.

Equipment

- Each team is to supply 1 match ball
- Each team is responsible for scoring each match (Scorers will sit together using the electronic score boards provided)
